Public Comments

Jess Perry of 1061 Walkup Ave Monroe came before the Planning Board to discuss 314 Cross St for the property owner, Fern Shubert. He was asking that the permit be approved for a microbrewery at 314 Cross St. Ms. Shubert believed that according to SIC Codes there should not be an issue. Board Member Mr. Weber said he did not feel comfortable making any decisions without other members there or the Planning/Zoning Administrator.
