COMMUNITY STRENGTH

Let's use a typical yard to see how a strong community functions and flows:

1. Look at the grass for an example of **Connectivity**: A lawn is unhealthy when there are only two blades of grass or a patch over here and over there. But when the grass is innumerable, close together, you'll see the reflection of a healthy yard.
2. Let's consider the plants and flowers as examples of **Productivity**: Plants and flowers pollinate and spread their seeds all over the place; that's growth. But when a plant or flower is unproductive, it neglects to share its beauty with others.
3. The trees are examples of **Generations**: Trees are the historians and anchors of the yard of a community. Older trees have seen the community grow and change, and they provide the nutrients, shade, and aesthetics needed to make a yard look great. Even when the grass, plants, and flowers undergo seasonal changes.

The strength of a community can be judged by its Connectivity, Productivity, and Generations, as exemplified by the grass, the plants and flowers, and the trees.
