## **ATTENTION!!**

Meter tampering by law is a Class I Misdemeanor offense.

Meter tampering includes the unauthorized connecting and disconnecting of utility services at the Town's meter by the owner or resident or the property, removal or damage to any part of the meter, removal or damage to any apparatus placed on the meter by the town, and also any action initiated by anyone other than the Town of Marshville to prevent access to the meter.
