Registration

Registration Fee \$25.00

Registration consists of a completed registration form as well as paid registration fee

Individuals ages 4 (on or before deadline) to age 7 (on or before deadline) are able to play

Teams

Players' ages are four to seven.

Players on a team – 5 minimum, 10 maximum

Parks & Recreation Department is responsible for assembling teams

Game Play

The Parks & Recreation Department is responsible for scheduling practices, and games. All provisions to schedule will be made only by Marshville Parks & Recreation.

Hats and Jerseys will be provided by Marshville Parks & Recreation

All practices, and games will be held at Marshville Municipal Park

50 feet between the bases.

Every player bats, each inning and plays in the field.

The ball is hit off a batting tee; there is no pitching.

There are no walks or strikeouts.

The ball must travel 10 feet or it is a foul.

No fielder may cross the playing line until the ball is hit.

No stealing. Player stays on the base until the ball is hit.

An inning is over when all the players have batted once.

Standard game is five innings, or 45 minute time limit.

Scores are not kept

Provided safety helmets must be worn.

Bats – 25"/26" long. 21/4" diameter, max. 17 to 20 ounces.

Balls (Provided) -9" to 9½" around; 4 to 5 ounces. Softer than a standard baseball. Molded core or sponge rubber center.

Gloves – 12" long, max.

Tee – adjustable, flexible tube on a moveable base.

Athletic footwear.

All other rules and regulations will follow Tee Ball USA guidelines
